OPTIONAL BUILD:

The 4 bricks placed in STEP 3 allow the drawer to slide back so the handle is inside of the cabinet. Placing these bricks 1 stud forward (against the tiles from STEP 2) makes the drawer handle stay on the outside of the cabinet, which some may find easier to grab onto.
